The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) was designed to facilitate the transfer of general education courses from a community college to a 4-year college or university in Michigan. To fulfill the Michigan Transfer Agreement, students must successfully complete at least 30 credits of MTA eligible courses with at least a 2.0 (C) in each course. Students must also complete at least one credit-bearing course at WCC.

To determine if you qualify for the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA), log into MyWCC to run a DegreeWorks audit. Select the *What-If* tool located on the left under the header box. In the drop down list for program select *Liberal Arts-MTA (CTLMTA)*. Click the blue *Process* button to see your audit.
