Question to Consider: What Is My Financial Plan?

- Starting with startup costs
 - Do I have an established relationship with a bank or lending institution?
 - What does my credit history look like?
 - EIN number information
 - What do I want to outsource, and what will I do myself?
 - SCORE's free financial planning templates, includes startup expenses, cost of goods sold, cash flow projections, etc.
- Funding resource list for small business



Question to Consider: How Will I Manage Bookkeeping and Taxes?

- Accounting and tax resources
 - Bookkeeping software for small business owners
 - Zipbooks, monthly fees: free and up, based on package
 - Freshbooks, monthly fees: 30-day free trial, monthly packages \$5 and up per month
 - Quickbooks, monthly fees: \$7 per month and up, based on package
 - Michigan Ross Free Accounting Fridays (now Wed and Fri)
 - SCORE Financial Planning Templates
 - Ask the EC for referrals



Question to Consider: What Types of Traditional Business Loans Are Available?
