

Writing Guide: Cause-and-Effect Essay

- The cause-and-effect essay analyzes the causes, or the effects, or the causes <u>and</u> effects of an event or situation.
- **<u>Causes</u>** are reasons for an event or situation.
- **<u>Effects</u>** are the results of an event or situation.

Causes ↓ Event or situation ↓ Effects

Essay Structures

- These are possible structures. The number of body paragraphs in an essay will, of course, vary, depending on the length of the assignment or the aspects to be analyzed.
- Remember that a good essay has <u>a point to prove</u>, which is usually stated explicitly in the <u>thesis</u>.
- A good essay also uses its <u>body paragraphs</u> to provide <u>support for that point</u> in the form of reasons, examples, facts, statistics, personal experience, or the opinions of experts
