

Patrol Stops: Preventing the Ambush

The officers will begin the encounter prior to making the stop with the assessment: Unknown, Elevated, or High Risk.

Strategies will be covered on approaches, positioning, controlling occupants and other relevant tactics to give the officers a tactical edge. Officers are encouraged to look beyond the initial violation and look for the bigger picture.

The format for this course is the model used with all Tactical Encounters courses; instruction, demonstrations, isolation drills and realistic scenarios using force-on-force application with the students to ensure they grasp the concepts and can apply them in real-life situations.
