Semi-Automatic Pistol Instructor

The course will cover laws, policies, fundamentals of shooting, shooting stance, nomenclature, instructional techniques, range set-up, building lesson plans, Target Focus Shooting, and hands on practice with actual students.

- Eye and ear protection
