WCC IMPORTANT TERMS

WCC Gateway: MyWCC, Blackboard, email, account balance and college resources.

MyWCC: Online place to register for classes, drop classes, print your class schedule, pay tuition, see your placement scores, view grades and much more.

Student ID#: Eight numbered identification at WCC. (@00 — — — — —)

NetID: Username used to login to <u>WCC Gateway</u>. Based on your name.

*Register: When you choose or add a course in WCC Gateway, Student Dashboard, you register for the class.

*Drop: By the refund deadline of ______ if you no longer want to take a class. You'll receive your money back.

*Withdrawal: 'W' is posted to your academic record when you withdraw from a class after the refund deadline and you don't get your money back.

CRN: Course Registration Number. This five-digit number identifies a class section with a specified day and time. The CRN is needed to register for classes online through MyWCC.

Cost for ESL Classes

4 Ways to Pay

When you register for a class, you must pay the tuition by the deadline (find online at wccnet. edu/payingtuition) or you will lose your seat in the class. Payment options include:

1. Online through MyWCC > Student Services > NEW Student Services Dashboard > Account Information > Pay tuition

2. ePayPlan

- If you are unable to pay your tuition full by the deadline, you can save your seat in the class by choosing our payment plan—ePayPlan. There is a \$25 fee that is paid right away and plans are available to pay your tuition bi-weekly or monthly. This option splits up the full price into pieces throughout the semester.
- **3.** Financial Aid (information on page 12 and 13)
- 4. In Cashier's Office, Student Center building, 2nd floor



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FINANCIAL AID

What is financial aid?

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Financial aid helps students pay for college. It can be used for expenses like tuition and fees, books and supplies, housing, and transportation. WCC offers four types of aid:

- 1. Grants: Based on your financial need with no repayment required.
- 2. Loans: Money that you borrow which must be repaid with interest.
- **3.** Scholarships: Based on GPA and/or financial need with no repayment required.
- 4. Work study: A work program where you earn money by working on campus.

How do I apply?

- 1. Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov
 - To avoid issues, make sure the name on your FAFSA matches exactly how it appears on your social security or permanent resident card.
 - WCC's Federal School Code is **002328**
- 2. Check your WCC email in 3-5 business days to determine your next steps. You may have other documents to turn in.

Keep in mind ...

- You must complete your classes with a C or better to continue receiving financial aid.
- Financial aid can be used to buy books if you transfer your funds to the bookstore in your MvWCC.
- Your information is private! If you want someone else, such as your spouse or a relative, to obtain your information from WCC, you must submit a Release of Information form with the Student Welcome Center.
- The amount of financial aid is determined by taking classes that are part of your program. In most cases, ESL and remedial courses are eligible.
- The Financial Aid Office is here to answer your questions. You can walk-in, call, email, meet on Zoom, or contact us in the website chat. We are happy to help!



COURSE SEARCH AND REGISTRATION



- 1. Click on WCC Gateway
- 2. Choose **Register** button
- **3.** Login using your netID and password
- **4.** Click on **registration**
- **5.** Click on register for classes
- **6.** Select term: **fall, winter, spring/summer**

- 7. Enter ESL, choose the class number of the course you wish you register for and then click **search**
- **8.** Review your options and select **add** for the section you want to register for.
- **9. Select** submit in the lower right corner to register for the course.
- **10.** Click on **schedule** and **options** to view your schedule. Email it to yourself or print it.


