### FEDERAL WORK STUDY ELIGIBILITY (FWS)

- Students must be awarded Federal Work Study (FWS) funds through the Financial Aid Office to be eligible for FWS
- First time awarded students must attend a mandatory FWS Orientation with WCC Career Services
- Returning/previously employed FWS students will need to pick-up a new Work Study Authorization form from the WCC Career Services Office
- Part time positions
- Up to 19.5 hours per week specifically for students who qualify for Financial Aid
- Federal Work Study jobs are not available for students on "Non-Immigrant" Visas (i.e. F-1 visa)
