WCC is no longer collecting applications to the Physical Therapist Assistant program for the Fall 2022 semester. **The application packet for the Fall 2023 semester is expected to become available mid-October 2022 with an anticipated application deadline in early January 2023.** All admission requirements must be successfully completed by the application deadline to be eligible to apply. Important Note Regarding Observation Hours:

Due to COVID-19, applicants to the Fall 2021 and Fall 2022 semesters were unable to complete the required 20 hours of observations in a physical therapy setting. Therefore, this requirement was temporarily waived. Prior to posting the Fall 2023 application packet, a final determination of this requirement for future applicants will be made based on CDC and official Public Health recommendations. However, if a decision regarding observation hours is made before the application is posted, this document will be updated to reflect the most recent information. **At this time, we recommend students wait until after a decision is made before completing any observation hours for the Fall 2023 admission cycle.**
