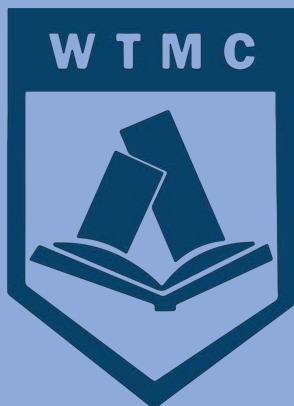

Final Soft Skill Credential Day *(No WTMC Classes)*

Friday, November 6 is the second soft skill credential day of the fall semester. Students have been working hard to demonstrate college-ready soft skills and teachers have been supporting that work with clear expectations and specific feedback.

Soft skill credentials will be posted the evening before credential day in PowerSchool. Here's a quick guide to your student's soft skill grades:

R = Ready	S = Satisfactory	N = Needs Improvement
The student has demonstrated college-readiness in BOTH soft skills and academic skills and is ready to move on to the college level in this subject.	The student has demonstrated college-ready soft skills, but needs more support academically in this subject before moving on to the college level.	One or more soft skills needs work, or the student needs to be more consistent with soft skills in this class.
