During the coming year, I can especially assist you with college selection, college applications, ACT and SAT testing information, and financial aid information. Please make an appointment to meet with me for a **Graduation Credit Review**. This is a critical step to ensure all requirements are met in order for you to graduate. Appointments are scheduled through Ms. Pause, you can stop in and see her in TI 218 A (across from elevator on second floor) or email her at <u>cpause@wccnet.edu</u>.

You must have completed your Graduation Credit Review no later than November 6, 2015 or Winter 2016 registration will be withheld.

Enclosed is a Graduation Credit Review Information Sheet for you to review prior to our meeting. Additionally, there is an Application for Graduation Form for WTMC and WCC, a WTMC Diploma form, and a Student Resume and Activity Sheet all of which need to be completed and turned in no later than November 6, 2015. Ideally, you can turn these in to me during our Credit Review meeting.

Please be aware that the determination for Honors at graduation will be based on your GPA at the end of Fall semester. Any coursework completed during Winter semester will not count towards honors status for graduation.

For those of you applying to college, be sure to visit each college website to check for details on dates, application deadlines, and deadlines for scholarship consideration.

Application for Graduation for WCC/WTMC and WTMC Diploma Form

- There are two Application for Graduation Forms that need to be completed. One for WTMC and at least one for WCC. WCC requires that one form be completed and turned in for each Certificate and/or Associate Degree you'll be obtaining.
- A Diploma Form for WTMC needs to be completed. If you are under 18 years of age, a parent signature is required.
- Forms and directions will be emailed by Mrs. Pause and also put on WTMC's website.
- All completed forms are turned in to Mrs. Pause no later than November 6, 2015.

Paying for College

• By applying and being accepted to a university, you may qualify for a Merit Based Scholarship, based solely on your grades and test scores.

• FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

• FAFSA is a form that is prepared annually by prospective college students to determine eligibility for student financial aid (student loans and grants). FAFSA has several different types of financial aid available. The most common are Stafford Loans, Perkins Loans, Pell Grants, and the Federal Work Study Program. Applications are accepted beginning January 1 of each year for the upcoming academic year. The majority of the loans and grants are available on a first come, first served basis. Students are advised to submit a FAFSA as early as possible for consideration for maximum financial assistance.

• State of Michigan (www.michigan.gov/mistudentaid)

- The Student Financial Services Bureau (SFSB), located within the Michigan Department of Treasury, encourages students to pursue postsecondary education by providing equality of access to student financial resources and information. Through the administration of various student financial assistance programs, students receive the guidance and funding necessary to pursue their educational goals.

Letters of Recommendation

- Choose a teacher who knows you well and can give specific examples of your performance and accomplishments.
- Get to know your WCC Program Advisor.
- Provide the recommender with your Student Resume and Activity Sheet, recommendation form, stamped envelope addressed to the college, and any other information they may need.
- Provide the recommender with enough time to meet deadlines (at least 2 weeks).

Transcript Requests

- WTMC and prior school transcripts are requested through Mrs. Pause.
- WCC transcript requests at Student Enrollment at the Student Center, 2nd Floor, Room 203.
